Conditions for participation:

- Participants must attend **2 of the 4 regular rehearsals**. Attendance at all rehearsals is recommended and attendance at the **Final Rehearsal on Friday** and **Dress Rehearsal on Saturday** is **mandatory**. Concert staging and seating is done at this final rehearsal, it is imperative that all are in attendance.
- Participants must carefully prepare all music and be aware of all of the dates. Folders will be given at a later date.
- All participants should bring a **folding music stand** to rehearsals. Drummers should bring a snare drum if they own one. Clarinet and saxophone students need **several good reeds** prior to rehearsal and concert. (Accessories are available on pemusicstore.com)
- Students need to be picked up immediately after each rehearsal.
- Student cell phones must remain off during rehearsal time or phone will be taken and returned after the rehearsal.
- Musicians will perform in black bottom and white top. (Performance will last about an hour.)
- Band tuition must be current. Please call our office if you have any questions.
